

PARISH PLAN 2015 – 2020

This Plan has been developed by Fouldeu Parish Council and represents the council's strategy for the next five years and beyond. A number of other on-going issues have been identified, for the management of the Recreation Ground, the renewal of the Village Hall, traffic management, litter, and care for the environment.

There are many challenges to be faced, not least the need to balance our limited budget but at the same time to pursue the many opportunities to shape the future for the benefit of people who will live in, work in and visit Fouldeu now and for years to come.

Priorities for Action

This Parish Plan identifies 10 priorities for action.

1. We will encourage, support and engage with initiatives, which make Fouldeu more sustainable as a place to live, work and play.
2. We will restore the Recreation Ground and evaluate the renewal of the existing equipment in an appropriate location and the upkeep and maintenance of the grounds.
3. We will set out and implement a plan for the upkeep and maintenance of the Village Hall and its grounds.
4. We will commission an external survey of street lighting and evaluate the recommendation for supplemental street lighting if needed.
5. We will work to improve road safety, accessibility and parking.
6. We will take measures to reduce crime and anti-social behaviour.
7. We will encourage property owners to improve maintain the curtilage of their property for the enjoyment of all residents.
8. We will maximise the investment opportunity for the funds held by the Highway Surveyor Land in Fouldeu and deploy the funds in support of community projects.
9. We will support high quality, sustainable, mixed development (supported by appropriate infrastructure improvements) that provides employment and housing to meet local needs and prepare a Neighbourhood Plan.
10. We will conserve and enhance our local heritage, landscape and biodiversity especially buildings of historical importance and wildlife conservation areas.
